
- Population: 190,790 in 2012

### Population Growth & Immigration

- Population Growth
  - **2000** 140,415
  - **2010** 183,275
  - **2011** 186,830
  - **2012** 190,790
- 2000 1.8% of the population, or 2,466 people, was Hispanic
- 2010 4.4% of the population, or 7,992 people, was Hispanic

#### Education

- Funding issues due to population growth
- Ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> to last in spending per student
- If educational quality decreases, children are not going to be prepared for the next grade level
- More importantly, they will not be prepared for the future
- Need new buildings, expansions
- Slow progress in special education programs


### Medical Services


- Thomas Hospital

- Effects of BP Oil Spill








# Environmental Issues



### Crime

- 90% of crimes believed to drug related
- Increase in crime rates in Baldwin County following the BP oil spill
  - Economic desperation
- Number of burglaries increased in 2011, following the return of the tourism industry along the Gulf Coast



# Housing



#### 2010

- 105,267 housing units
- 11,742 mobile homes
- 220 boats, RV, vans, or other vehicles recognized as living structures
- 449 lacked complete plumbing facilities
- 905 lacked complete kitchen facilities
- 2,302 households without telephone service

### Racial Tensions

- Culture & social hierarchy
- Poverty disproportionately affects minorities in Baldwin County
- Unemployment
  - 7.7% of white population
  - 12.0% of black population
  - 13.3% of Hispanic population

#### 2000


- Population: 140,415

- Family poverty rate: 9.5%


# Summary of Issues
